

BRING YOUR OWN SUBSCRIPTION (BYOS) FOR BIM 360 DESIGN

Important: Before starting the trial setup, contact NTI A/S for correct setup between trials and paid BIM 360 sites to meet terms of use.

The Bring Your Own Subscription (BYOS) policy defines access to modules and services within BIM 360 Design. BYOS does not apply to [other BIM 360 product subscriptions](#).

BYOS allows project administrators to invite other subscribers of BIM 360 Design (internal or external to the company) to join a BIM 360 project without having to assign one of their own subscriptions.

With BYOS, you as a BIM 360 Design subscriber can access Revit Cloud Worksharing in Revit, the Collaboration for Civil 3D service, and the Design Collaboration and Document Management modules in BIM 360 for any BIM 360 project you are invited to. This applies:

- Regardless of the individual or business entity that owns the BIM 360 account hosting the project.
- Regardless of which individual or business entity purchased the subscription to BIM 360 Design (subject to conformance with the [Authorized User](#) definition and other conditions in the Autodesk Terms of Use).
- Regardless of the user limit in the BIM 360 account.
- As long as the Revit Cloud Worksharing and Collaboration for Civil 3D entitlements have been [assigned appropriately in Autodesk Accounts](#).
- As long as you have been [granted access to these services](#) in the desired BIM 360 project.

HOW DOES BYOS WORK?

Access to BIM 360 Modules

Access to the modules in BIM 360 Design is given by inviting a user to join a project. A project administrator assigns access to the Document Management and Design Collaboration modules.

- Invited users who have a BIM 360 Design subscription can access the Design Collaboration and Document Management modules in any project they have access to.
- If an invited user does not have a BIM 360 Design subscription, the administrator can assign one of their own subscriptions to the user to grant access. This will reduce the number of subscriptions in the administrator's available pool.

ACCESS TO REVIT CLOUD WORKSHARING AND COLLABORATION FOR CIVIL 3D

Access to Revit Cloud Worksharing and Collaboration for Civil 3D must be provided in Autodesk Accounts.

- To use Revit Cloud Worksharing and Collaboration for Civil 3D, a subscription must be assigned to a user in [Autodesk Accounts](#). This subscription can come from the user's own subscription to BIM 360 Design or it can be assigned by an administrator in compliance with the limitations in the [Authorized User](#) definition in the Autodesk Terms of Use. This allocation consumes a subscription to BIM 360 Design for that contract.

EXAMPLE SCENARIOS

- Company A has 25 subscriptions of BIM 360 Design and all are used by A employees
- Company B has 25 subscriptions of BIM 360 Design and all are used by B employees
- Company C has 25 subscriptions of BIM 360 Docs and all are used by C employees
- Company D has 25 subscriptions of BIM 360 Docs and all are used by D employees

Scenario 1

Company A invites 5 users of Company B to join Company A's BIM 360 project. Does Company A need to purchase additional subscriptions to BIM 360 Design for company B?

- No. Since Company B users already have their own BIM 360 Design subscriptions and entitlements to Revit Cloud Worksharing and Collaboration for Civil 3D assigned in Autodesk Accounts, they can join the project and have access to the project without the need for Company A to purchase any additional subscriptions.

Scenario 2A

Company A invites 5 users of Company C to join Company A's BIM 360 project. If Company A wants Company C to have Revit Cloud Worksharing and Collaboration for Civil 3D access in Company A's project, is there a need to purchase additional subscriptions for Company C?

- Yes. Since Company C does not have subscriptions to BIM 360 Design, additional subscriptions are required for Company C to have Revit Cloud Worksharing and Collaboration for Civil 3D access. These additional BIM 360 Design subscriptions can be purchased by either Company A or Company C.

Scenario 2B

What if Company A only wants Company C to have Document Management access to Company A's project?

- In this case Company A will have to purchase 5 subscriptions of BIM 360 Docs for use by Company C on the project. Since the BYOS policy does not apply to the BIM 360 Docs product, Company C can't use their BIM 360 Docs subscriptions on Company A's project.

Scenario 3

Company C invites 5 users of Company D to Company C's BIM 360 project. Does Company C have to purchase additional subscriptions of BIM 360 Docs?

- Yes. Since both Company C and D have BIM 360 Docs subscriptions, BYOS does not apply. Company C will have to purchase 5 more subscriptions of BIM 360 Docs for Company D users invited to their project.
